



Mac Users: The screenshots here are from the Windows version of MapInstall, but the Mac version will be nearly identical.

PC Instructions

1. Download and install [Basecamp](#).
2. Download and install [MapInstall](#).
3. Run the map installer you downloaded from RedPine-Mapping.com and follow the prompts to install the map on your computer.

Note: You can also use the included RPM Map Loader program to avoid downloading and installing the two programs above.

Mac Instructions:

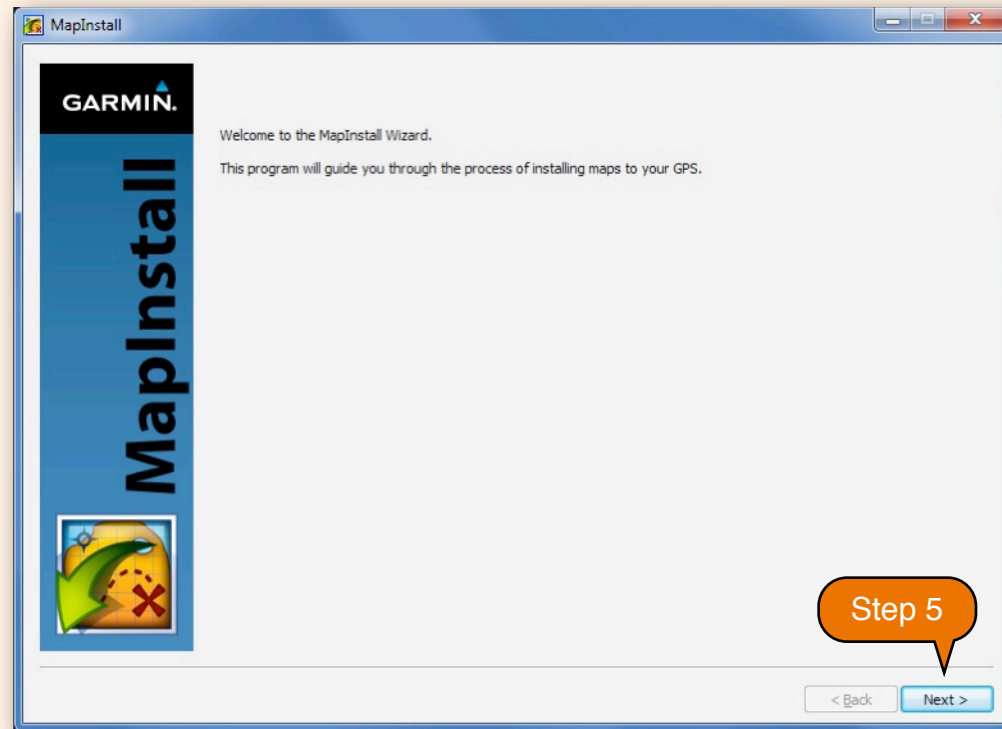
1. Download and install [MapManager](#) and [MapInstall](#).
2. Unzip the map you downloaded from RedPineMapping.com, and open it with MapManager, and follow the prompts to install the map on your computer.

Mac and PC Instructions:

3. Connect the media you want to store the map on to your computer.
This can be your GPS if you want to store the map on its internal memory, your GPS with an SD card in it, or an SD card connected via a card reader or SD card slot on your computer.
4. Run MapInstall. You will see a screen like the one pictured here.
5. Click Next.
5. Select the location where you want to store the map.
Choices may include your GPS's internal memory, an SD card inside your GPS, or an SD card plugged into your computer.

If nothing shows up under "Device," check your connections and click the "Find Device" button.

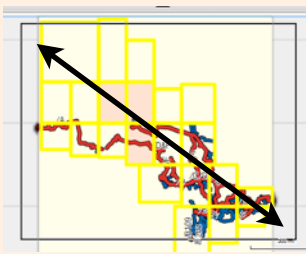
7. Click Next.



8. Choose the map you want to install (if you have multiple maps).

9. The gray boxes over the map are regions that can be loaded onto your GPS individually. You can select as many as the available memory of your device can store (storage capacity is shown on the right of the screen).

You can click each one individually, or click in a corner of the map and drag a box across to select multiple regions at once:



10. Once you have your regions selected, switch to any other maps you want to install now using the drop-down menu and select your desired regions. **All maps you want to have on your GPS must be installed at the same time. Any user installed maps (factory installed maps are permanent) you have on your GPS will be replaced with what you're sending to it now.**

11. Click Next.

12. Click Next.

MapInstall will now begin loading the map(s) onto your GPS or memory card. This process can take anywhere from a few seconds to several minutes, depending on your hardware and how many maps you've chosen.

Disconnect your GPS or SD card when the process is complete. See our Map Usage instructions for information about using the maps on your GPS.
